Authors are to note the following:

1. All papers, not exceeding 15 pages of A4 paper should be scholarly-and typed double spaced computer. Three copies should be submitted to the Editor for assessment. Originality of article is highlY empbasized. .
2. The abstract should be precise and must not exceed 200 words.
3. Tables, diagrams, graphs and other illustrations should be infused inside the body of the article where necessary or put in appendix if too large. ' .
4. The approved referencing style is the current American Psychcloglcal Associatlon (APA) format.
5. Author's names, designations and affiliations, e-mail and phone number(s) should be typed on a separate sheet and attached to the article.
6. All articles should be forwarded with two stamped self-addressed envelopes (of 10 by 8cm) and non-refundable assessment fee of N5,000:00 payable in cash or bank draft only to, The Editor, LIJOPOL.
7. If a paper is found publishable, author(s) are expected to pay publication fee of N20,000.00
8. Papers already submitted for publication elsewhere should NOT be submitted to LIJOPOL for consideration.
9. Book reviews are also accepted for publication.
